The consortium of developers for the South Wokingham Strategic Development south of the Reading-Waterloo railway line are holding two exhibitions of their plans for that area, as follows:

- from 11 am to 4 pm on Saturday 3 November in the Cornerstone, All Saints Church, Norreys Avenue
 - from 12 noon to 8 pm on Thursday 8 November in Wokingham Town Hall, Market Place.
- The development is intended to include 1600 dwellings, a primary school, a local centre and natural green space.

Members of the Wokingham Society Executive Committee will discuss the proposals after the exhibitions are over, and decide on a response to the plans.

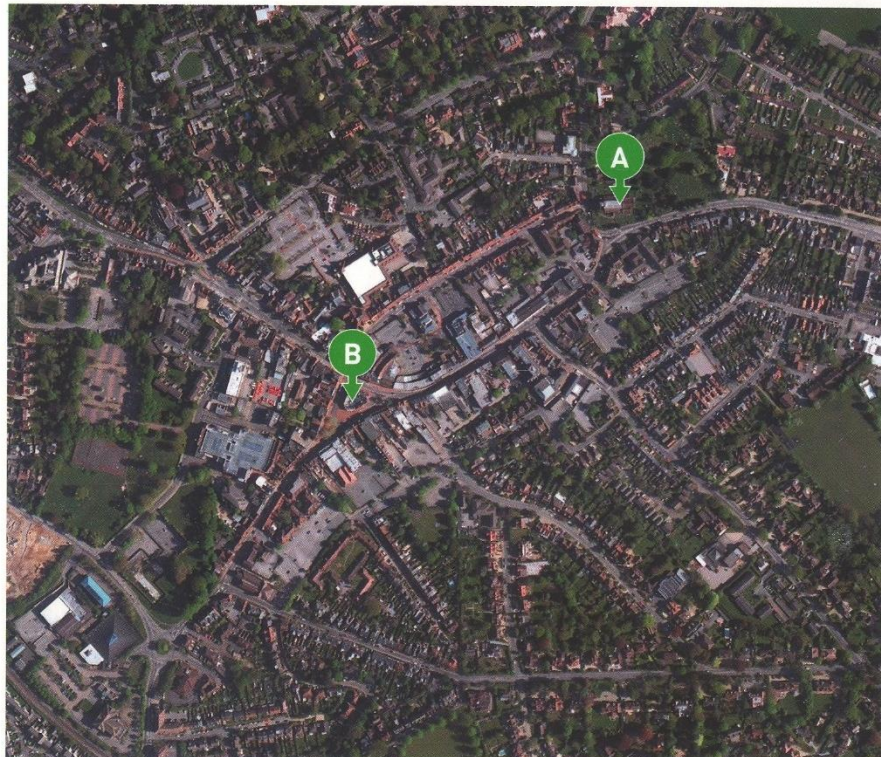

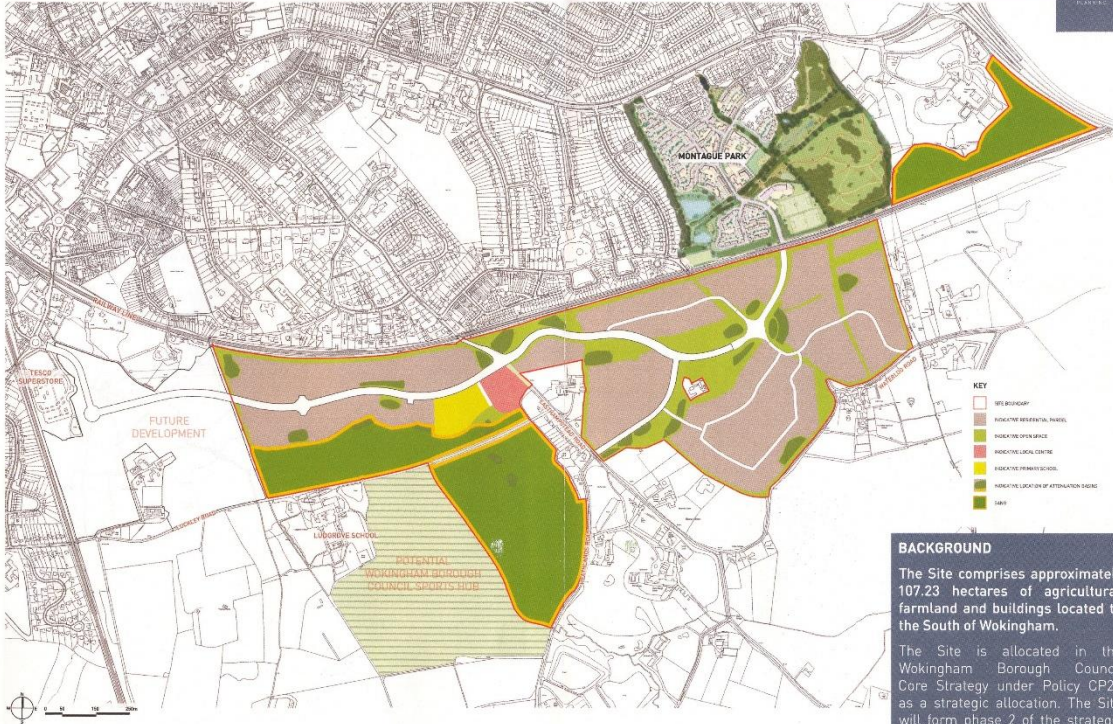
B: Wokingham Town Hall, Market Place, RG40 1AS, Thursday 8th November 12:00 – 20.00

INDICATIVE AREAS PLAN

BACKGROUND

The Site comprises approximately 107.23 hectares of agricultural farmland and buildings located to the South of Wokingham.

The Site is allocated in the Wokingham Borough Council Core Strategy under Policy CP21 as a strategic allocation. The Site will form phase 2 of the strategic allocation, the first phase being Montague Park to the north of the railway line.
